Our USE IT Act Summary compiles GSA's USE IT Act Occupancy Data Reports, which federal agencies must submit annually. GSA provides usable office space summaries for each agency, but no comprehensive report for all agencies was available. Therefore, we developed this consolidated report. Office Usable SF refers to working office space only, while Total Usable SF includes all spaces such as conference halls, laboratories, libraries, etc. All reported use rates are below 60%, though the data covers only the period from January 12, 2026, to March 6, 2026. The USE IT Act requires action if the use rate stays below 60% for a full year.
